HEN Fellows – TEAM KNA! Goals of the Project:

- (1) Design and develop the Kentucky Nurses Resource Book.
- (2) Develop a Marketing Campaign (for the Kentucky Nurses Resource Book).

HEN Fellows – TEAM KNA! Initial focus: Customer discovery



Team Action: Interview Nurse Educators about the Resource Book.

Highlights:

- * Focus on promoting the value of the Resource Book.
 - As a recruiting tool for higher positions.
 - As a source for expertise.
 - As a source for mentors for other nurses with specific skills/specialties.
 - As a source to mine for committee membership and advocacy groups.
 - As a source to build a think tank for crisis situations.
 - Athletic departments and schools/child care facilities for interest.
- * Outreach to nurses to participate; nurses can:
 - Have more influence with highlighted expertise.
 - Have better job opportunities
 - Be empowered as nurses in KY: KNA membership and engagement.



HEN Fellows – TEAM KNA! Initial focus: Customer discovery

Team Action: Survey Nurses about the KY Nurses Resource Book. *Results*:

- 93% of Nurses surveyed were interested in the concept of the KY Nurses Resource Book and would participate.
- 83% of the Nurses surveyed were willing to pay a fee to participate in the Resource Book.
 - All of the Nurses surveyed were concerned about a fee higher than \$60.
- All of the Nurses surveyed were interested in the Resource Book for either new job or networking opportunities.







Did you know?...



- * Nurses walk 4 miles every shift!

- * There are over 100 nursing professions available to nurses!
- * There are 300 MILLION nurses in the United States!

Nurses are Innovators!

* In 1963, Anita Dorr created the crash cart and developed it in her basement. Now everyone uses them.



- * Teri Barton-Salinas and Gail Barton-Hay (sisters) patented their color-coded I.V. lines in 2003.
- * In 1954, Elise Sorensen's little sister, Thora, had surgery for colon cancer. She faced life with an ostomy appliance that often smelled bad and leaked. Elise created a plastic ostomy bag that adheres to the body. It's still used today.





Helpful Hints to KNA for Maintaining the KY Nurses Resource Book.

Team Action: Gather and compile information from Nurse Educators.

Results:

- Data Integrity.
 - > If self-reported, may need to check information.
 - > Update Nurse entries at least annually.
- Content.
 - > Focus on unique items/characteristics that cannot be found on google.
 - > Add new characteristics each year to keep it fresh.
